****NOTE:** Students must have at least a 2.5 GPA both in their Liberal Studies major and overall to be eligible for student teaching placement. They must also be formally admitted to the teacher preparation program and have at least a "C" in English 150 (RBC English 101). To obtain licensure students must maintain a 2.75 GPA in the professional semester and achieve a passing score on PRAXIS I and II.
