



Longwood University is a coeducational, comprehensive, public university.

**LOCATION:** Located in the Heart of Virginia, in a dynamic two-college town – approximately 60 miles west of Richmond; 60 miles south of Charlottesville, and 50 miles east of Lynchburg.

**ENROLLMENT:** 4,700 total; 4,000 undergraduates; 1050 freshmen; 180 transfers; 35% male; 12% minority; 10% out-of-state (20 other states and countries represented)

**MAJORS:** Bachelor's degrees in: Anthropology, Art (Art History/ Graphic Design/Photography/Education, etc), Biology, Athletic Training, Business Administration (Accounting/Marketing/Management/Education/Finance/Computer Information Systems/Real Estate/Retail), Communication Disorders, Communication Studies, Chemistry, Computer Science, Criminology and Criminal Justice, Economics, English, Foreign Language (French/German/Spanish), History, Kinesiology (Exercise Science/K-12 Teaching), Liberal Studies (Elementary/Middle/Special Education), Mathematics, Music, Nursing, Physics, Political Science, Psychology, Social Work, Sociology, Theatre, and Therapeutic Recreation. 5-year Programs: Special Education; all arts and sciences majors/MBA combination (optional); and all business majors/MBA combination (optional).

**MINORS:** (in addition to majors listed above) Homeland Security, Computer Security, Forensics & Law, Leadership Studies, International Studies, Military Science, Philosophy, Women's & Gender Studies.

**TUITION, ROOM, BOARD AND FEES:** In-State - \$16,500/year; Out-of-State - \$25,800/year (based on 30 credit hours, 14 + 150 meal plan); Commuters - \$8,925/year.

**STATS:** Average class size: 26; Student/faculty ratio: 20:1; Graduate Assistants teaching: 0

**ADMISSIONS:** Fall 2009 Accepted Students: SAT average: 1095 Mid-range: 1020 – 1150 GPA: 3.4 Mid-range: 3.1 – 3.7

**DEADLINES:** Early Action – December 1 (with notification in January)  
Nursing - January 15 (with notification in March)  
Priority – March 1 (for freshmen and transfers)

**MINIMUM REQUIRED HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS/YEARS:** English – 4; Math – 3 (must include Algebra I and II and Geometry); Science – 3 (2 of which must include a lab); Social Studies – 3; Foreign Language – 2 (additional years of one language strongly recommended; ASL does not meet this requirement for admission purposes); Health/Physical Education – 2; Fine/Practical Art – 1.

**INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS:** TOEFL minimum requirement: 550 (paper); 213 (computer); 79-80 (internet)

**INTERNSHIP/DIRECTED RESEARCH/STUDY ABROAD:** Required of all students in all majors.

**SPECIAL FEATURES:** Approximately 70% of students live in university sponsored housing. Campus fully wired and/or wireless. Each student is required to have a laptop.

**ATHLETICS:** NCAA Division I - Men's teams – baseball, basketball, cross-country, golf, soccer, and tennis. Women's teams – basketball, cross-country, field hockey, golf, lacrosse, soccer, softball, and tennis.

**CLUB SPORTS:** Cheerleading, equestrian, in-line hockey, rugby, swimming, etc.

**INTRAMURALS:** Basketball, bowling, golf, racquetball, soccer, softball, swimming, volleyball, etc.

**ACTIVITIES:** Over 125 clubs and organizations: academic clubs, Big Siblings, Company of Dancers, 9 fraternities; Habitat for Humanity, Longwood Radio, music groups, 12 sororities, Student Government Association, student publications, theatre, etc.
